## Research grant – Call for projects Appendix to the "Auschwitz Foundation Prizes" regulations

The Auschwitz Foundation offers an annual research grant of  $\in 3,125$ , which is matched by a "Foundation Auschwitz - Jacques Rozenberg research grant" of the same amount, offered by the *Fondation Rozenberg-Caillet - Mains Ouvertes, Dignité de Vie.* Both grants are intended to finance a historical or cultural project by a student, young researcher or artist.

Following research areas are eligible for the grant:

- National Socialism and the Third Reich (history, politics, economy, society, culture and ideology).
- Nazi crimes, genocides and the systems and processes that have given rise to them.
- The consequences of these events for contemporary society and the collective memory.
- Similar events in the past and present.

Particular attention will be given to projects with a cultural focus, such as scenarios, documentaries, feature films, plays, works of art, etc.

The two selected projects are preferably being developed in coordination with a high-level national or international university or research institution. The project may last between one and three years and will be linked to a publication contract.

The submission deadline has been set annually on January 31st. The submitted projects will be reviewed by a committee of experts.
